There are 120 non-military accredited urology residency programs in the United States. (Military programs cannot participate due to government regulations regarding eligibility.) For 2010, 114 non-military accredited urology residency programs in the United States listed 268 positions with 260 vacancies being matched. 337 applicants submitted preference lists netting 77 unmatched applicants. Of U.S. senior medical students applying, 88 percent were matched.
